Understanding Education and Development; 6 hours. Participants explore the role of education in international development and relate this to educational partnerships and the curriculum.

Child Rights and Global Citizenship; Variable course durations, select from 4 hrs, 6 hrs, 12 hrs. This course stimulates critical thinking about rights-related issues at whole school and curriculum/ learner level. The main themes can include Fair Trade/trade justice; British values/ Community Cohesion & Multicultural Britain (SMSC); Sustainability; Measuring Attitudinal Change in Pupils & Curriculum Planning all set in the context of child rights and responsibilities. Active and Global Citizenship; 2 x 3hours (6 hours) This course inspires and supports classroom practitioners (including HLTAs) in the practical delivery of global learning within the curriculum. Increase their capability to engage reluctant learners with the curriculum using global learning /development education as an entry point through literacy, numeracy and active citizenship. Cost; £90 ecredits pp or £400 ecredits for 1 school. Price on application for a cluster of schools.


Curriculum & subject support – learning from Kenya with Makutano Junction; 4 hours. This course aims to support excellence in teaching and learning through subjects, by increasing global learning delivery. It enables teachers to consider using popular media in the classroom as a tool to engage & inspire pupils to learn, and to identify methodology and challenging stimuli for critical and reflective learning. Distant Localities; 2 hrs. This course helps to generate an appreciation of the links and connections (interdependences) between the lives of others and children's own lives. Learning what life is like for others, brings an increased understanding of how the world is a global community and what it means to be a citizen within it.
