Large Tin Plate	With flowers in a vase decoration. For communal eating – staple food injera, a large flat bread.		
Small Tin Plate	With yellow and green decoration in 4 parts		
Metal Drinking Cup	Decorated with a blue lion.		
Metal Pouring Vessel	With long handle and pouring spout. (adding water to coffee pot		
Metal Pan	With long handle for roasting coffee beans.		
Miniature Stove	Three pieces. Used with charcoal to prepare coffee		
Full-sized Coffee Pot	Silver metal with round base.		
Coffee Pot Stand	Painted green with white and red dots.		
4 Coffee Cups	Porcelain – made in china.		
Large Palm Leaf Mat	Used to turn over large injera (pancake)		

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

Brush	Made of palm for sweeping floors.		
Goat Skin Rug	For wall decoration. Decorated with lady in green shawl – marked 'Bilen Eritrea'. Bilen is 1 of the 9 languages spoken in Eritrea.		
Christmas Star Mat	Made with foil food wrappers and sewn on to a raffia mat.		
3 Mats	For fanning a fire or used as wall decorations.		
2 Shopping Bags	Cotton fabric. One with Arabic writing, one with Eritrea & a camel. Eritrea has banned plastic carrier bags

Pink/Purple Pot & Lid	Hand made.		
Perfume Bottle & Cap	Toy decorated with pink & white plastic and small gold balls.		
Basket	Toy made from red velvet.		
Coffee Pot & Stand	Toy made from red velvet.		
Plastic Basket	Toy decorated with small gold balls.

2 Pairs Boy's Sandals	Black.		
2 Boy's Hats	Embroidered with Islamic patterns.
