Most of the items in this collection are from northern Nigeria and reflect the lifestyle of the nomadic Fulani people.

3 x Working Women	These models depict women working. Note that they work while carrying their babies in slings on their backs.		
3 x Gourd Dishes	Made from half gourds and decorated.		
Brush	Made from grasses and bound with twine.		
2 x Carved Models	Land rover and woman mixing in large dish – decorative.		
5 x Model Tools	Models of agricultural tools with decorated handles.		
Kalabash Flask	Decorated with okra net – could be used as musical instrument.		
2 x Head Rings	Used for carrying heavy items (water jugs, bales etc).		
Leather Wallet	Hand made and decorated with inlaid leather strips.		
Leather Purse	Hand sewn with decorated hems.		
2 x Wall Decorations	Printed with traditional figures.		
Cloth Strip	Printed and embroidered with coloured cotton bobbles. Used as either a hammock, a bed/chair decoration or a scarf. The type of decoration denotes status (importance) to the Yoruba people.		
Elephant Stool/Table	Hand carved from local wood.

2 x Woven Platters	Could be used as winnowing baskets.		
1 x Woven Flask			
Face Mask	Hand carved and used as a wall decoration.		
3 x Handbags			
3 x Traditional Men's Hats	Hand sewn, worn as part of traditional costume; visiting mosque.		
Men's Outfit	Trousers, long shirt & hat.		
Album with Photo & Text	A traditional men's hat worn during the annual hunting festival.		
7 x Cloth Pieces	Printed with traditional patterns – 'Kampala'.		
3 x Cloth Smocks	Printed with traditional patterns – 'Kampala attire'.		
1 x Cloth Dress	Printed with traditional pattern.		
Leather Holdall	Decorated with traditional patterns.		
2 x Leather Cushions	Green and white.		
13 x Books	The Distant Talking Drum. My Grandfather is a Magician. One Big Family. Ebele's Favourite.
