### FABRICS & CLOTHING

		IN	OUT
<b>Manta or Chusi</b>	A large, square, black and orange shawl or blanket – fine wool fabric, natural dyes.		
<b>Poncho</b>	Black, white, grey. Alpaca & wool fabric, natural dyes.		
<b>Chumpis x3</b>	The red and beige belt is in traditional colours using natural dyes. The other two belts use artificially dyed threads.		
<b>Mantas x2</b>	Large woven squares made from synthetic materials.		
<b>Traditional Hat</b>	Hand knitted with pom poms in modern colours.		
<b>Wall Hanging</b>			
<b>Sandals x2 pairs</b>	Adult's and child's sandals made from tyres.		

### TOYS

<b>Dolls x3</b>	In traditional dress. A boy, a woman and a replica ancient doll that represents the sort of doll given to newly-weds as blessing and asking for fertility and many children.		
<b>Boxed Game</b>	Set of figures (4 women and 4 llamas) for a noughts and crosses game in a half-moon shaped box.		
<b>Condor Figures x2</b>			
<b>Cooking Toys x 12 items</b>	2 x stoves, 10 x pots/dishes.		
<b>Wooden Toys x8 items</b>	Spinning top, large and small 'catch ball' games, pestle and mortar, mallet, rolling pin and little board.		

### MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS

<b>Zampona</b>	Pan pipes.		
<b>Quena</b>	Plain wood flute.		
<b>Recorder</b>	Patterned wood.		
<b>Ocarina</b>	Whistle made from clay.		
<b>Hand-Held Drums x 2</b>	The beads act as the strike mechanism.		
<b>Rattles x 2</b>	Made from a llama's hoof and from seeds.		
<b>Shaker</b>	Made from a gourd.		
<b>Skin Drum</b>	Made from wood with animal skin and attached strikers.		
<b>Leaflet</b>	Laminated leaflet – How to play the Zampona (in Folder 3).		
<b>Leaflet</b>	Laminated leaflet – How to play the Quena (in Folder 3).		

### FOOD

<b>Seed Strips</b>	Examples of the many different seed crops grown in Peru (many different types of corn).		
<b>Pack of Herbs</b>	Traditional herbs and seasoning for drink.		
<b>Wooden Cooking Tools</b>	2 hand-made cooking spoons local to the Cusco region.
