Track Suit	JACKET AND TROUSERS (Dilzintaba Senior Secondary School uniform). These are commonly used as winter uniform.		
Football Shirt	With Vodacom and Kaiser chiefs motifs (A South African premier club)		
Oil Lamp	This is a miniature of lamps commonly used in rural homes in South Africa. It works with oil, paraffin or white spirit.		
Tilly lamp	Works with paraffin		
Stainless Steel Bowl	This has a wide range of uses eg. Washing and cooking.		
Football	Made by children from plastic bags and maize meal sacks.		
Enamel Mug and Plate	At mealtimes, children in rural areas and some towns tend to eat and drink from enamel rather than china. Enamel is often for everyday use in rural locations and the china is kept for "best".		
Wooden Spoon	Every home will have a number of these. Used for making porridge/mealie pap and accompanying dishes.		
Brush	A lot of pride goes into keeping homes clean and tidy. All homes and schools will use brushes made from locally available grasses as well as shop-bought dustpan & brush sets.		
3 x Silk Scarves	Married women in rural areas wear these at home or when going out. Known as a Dhuk.		
5 x Fabric Pieces	Traditional prints that are made into dresses/smocks. These are worn mostly by older women and those in Eastern Cape/ Lesotho.		
2 x Dolls	Fabric doll with multi-coloured outfit made by a women's self-help group. Bead doll from Monkeybiz South Africa (in SA Beadwork wallet)		
1 x Rucksack	Contains pencil case with assorted writing things, one brush as used to clean classroom.
